Carriage

Carriages and Carriage Parts - Rated by the tine carriage lifting capacity, there are four sizings of hook type tine carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted tines vary by the amount of offset between the tine and the blade eye. Various makers would vary the carriages for pin type tines. Carriage capacity will be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
